

In the Name of God Amen this Twenty fifth Day of September In fourth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third and In the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty four I Samuel Terrill of the Borough of Slipton In the County of Essex and Province of New Jersey Weaver being Sick and weak in Body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be Given to God; Therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to Dye, do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say, principally and first of all I Give & Recommend my Soul into the Hands of God that gave it, and my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a Decent and Christian manner at the Direction of my Executors Nothing Doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as Touching such worldly Estate where with it hath pleased God to Bless me in this Life, I Give and Bequeath the same in the Following Manner and form

Imprimis First It is my Will that all my Just Debts be paid & Discharged in some convenient time after my Decease by my Executors here after Mentioned Desiring one or all of them to sell of my Moveable Estate all except what my wife shall think proper to keep for the Benefit of the place and Likewise to sell all that piece or Tract of Land that I Bought of Henry Bennel which formerly belonged to Benjamin Ware Deceas In order to Discharge my Debts and if it should not be enough then my will is that my Executors sell as much of my other Land where they shall think proper as will Discharge the Balance of my Debts

Item Secondly it is my will that my Dearly Beloved wife Mary shall have the use Benefit and Improvement of all my Lands Meadows Buildings and Tenements that I shall hereinafter any Just Debts be paid During the whole time she shall continue my widow But if she Marry again my will is and I do hereby Ordain that she shall have the sum of Twenty pound Current Lite money of New Jersey at Eight Shillings the pound to be paid out of my Estate and then to quit the possessions of my Houses Lands and Tenements for Ever

Item Thirdly It is my Will and I do hereby Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Sons all my Lands Meadows Houses and Buildings to be equally Divided among them when they shall arrive to the age of Twenty one years to have and to hold the same to them their Heirs and assigns for Ever I also order that my son Nathaniel shall take Care of my Brother Lemuel Terrill and also the Care of my two youngest Sons Amos & John so far as to Use his Endeavour to see that they have their

Item I Give and Bequeath to Each of my Daughters ~~that are yet Alive~~ the sum of Fifteen Pound Current Lite money of the Province aforesaid when they shall be Eighteen years to have and to hold to their own proper use and behoof

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Item I make Ordain Constitute and appoint my Loving Wife Mary and my Trusty and Beloved
Friends Amos Day and William Brant the Joint Executors and Executors of this my Last
Will and Testament and do Revoke Rescind and make Void all former Wills & Testaments
By me in any manner of ways heretofore made and Declared here by Ratifying and Confirming
this to be my Last will and Testament and No other in Testimony whereof I have to this
my Last will and Testament set my hand and affixed my Seal the Day and year above written
